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Notice Concerning Retirement and Appointment of Asset Management Company Director

Japan Prime Realty Investment Corporation (JPR) today announced details of the resignation of a director and a resolution of the Board of Directors of Tokyo Realty Investment Management, Inc. (TRIM), a licensed asset management company retained by JPR to provide asset management services. The resolution, approved at the TRIM's Board of Directors' meeting held today, proposed a candidate as a new director for consideration at the general meeting of shareholders scheduled for February 29, 2012.

In addition, TRIM intends to hold a Board of Directors' meeting on February 29, 2012 following the conclusion of the general meeting of shareholders.
